- Copies of any Practical / Theory certificates
- Any further documentation to support your application

Preparing for the Scholarship Interview

To prepare for the Scholarship interview, your child is required to write a letter to the Principal which needs to include:

- Why your child would like to be a part of the St Andrew's School community
- How your child can make a difference as a student at St Andrew's School
- What extra activities your child would like to be involved in as a student at St Andrew's School.

The Scholarship Selection Process

After a review of the information provided and the results from the interview, a shortlist of candidates will be finalised. The Principal shall award the Scholarships offered at her absolute discretion. The Scholarship is awarded on the proviso that your child continues to maintain satisfactory high standards of academic achievement, participates to the very best of their ability in school life and adheres to School policy. Successful candidates of the Bright Futures Scholarship may receive a remission of up to half of the base Tuition Fees each year to the conclusion of Year 6 at St Andrew's School.

Only one form of discount applies. A student in receipt of a scholarship is not also eligible for any other discounts. For successful candidates, completion of the St Andrew's application form, payment of the Confirmation Fee of \$825, along with the refundable Tuition Bond of \$1700 will be required to proceed with application. A copy of the child's birth certificate will be required, in accordance with established enrolment procedure, as proof of age.

The scholarship examination will be held at St Andrew's School, 22 Smith Street, Walkerville on Saturday 5 February 2022. Parking is available on Smith Street or Church Terrace.

You must arrive no later than 8.40am and staff will be present to assist with direction. Candidates will not be admitted after 8.45am. Candidates will be notified within six weeks.

Please note: By accepting the Bright Futures scholarship, it is a requirement that the student stays at St Andrew's School until the completion of Year 6.
